Immanuel Lutheran Church in Norwood Pennsylvania has a treasure that turns 80 years old this year. It is a hand painted mural on the back wall of our sanctuary which was painted by renowned 1930's Philadelphia artist Mirian Tindall Smith in loving memory of her Mother, Jennie Minerva Tindall. The mural which is nearly 70 feet across, towers to the peak of the ceiling and took nearly two years to complete. Above is the central scene is the Sermon on the Mount that shows Jesus and his camp of followers.

Below are the scenes over the entrance doors....on the left is a scene portraying Jesus with Mary Magdalene in the Garden of Gethsemane and on the right is a scene of Jesus with the blind Beggars.
